ABOUT THE PROJECT

The Khushee Mamta program is a 2-year international collaborative project between Mount Royal University (Canada), University of Ottawa (Canada), Queen's University (Canada), London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine (UK), Sangath (Goa, India), and the Mata Jai Kaur Maternal and Child Health Centre (MJK - Rajasthan, India). The program uses locally recruited lay counsellors to provide mental health care for pregnant women and new mothers. We aim to evaluate outcomes both qualitatively and quantitatively, and to critically inform implementation using community- based, participatory, and innovative qualitative methods.
